

Hunter and Light Horse Section Rules

- 1) All horses to be accompanied by passports and have current equine influenza vaccination.
- 2) Any rider who has 2 horses entered in the same class of working hunter must, after the jumping section, choose one horse to take forward to the flat section of the class.
- 3) After the jumping section the judge may decide that only horses with clear rounds or minimal faults go forward to the flat section of this class.
- 4) All winners and second placed riders from all classes must make themselves available for the championship.
- 5) If a rider should have a fall from their mount they will be asked to leave following any medical attention.
- 6) Any person's behaviour on the show field that is deemed by officials to be inappropriate or contrary to the welfare of any person or animal will be ordered to desist and may be disqualified from taking any further part in the show.
- 7) A judge that falls from a horse must not remount.
- 8) Riding hats or skull caps with a three point harness must be worn whenever mounted.
- 9) Riders under 16 on show day must wear an approved body protector when mounted.
- 10) Bits to be of snaffle, Pelham or Curb type. No running gags or bitless bridles. If in doubt check with chief steward.
- 11) No draw reins in collecting ring.
- 12) No lunging on field.
- 13) No schooling or cutting whips. Standard riding whips only to be used.
- 14) Protective boots may be worn for jumping, but removed for flat section of class.
- 15) Any piece of equipment deemed unsuitable for the classes will be removed before the competitor can continue.
