ALL classes are OPEN unless otherwise stated.

LOCAL (SHOW AREA) is confined to entrants residing within a ten mile radius of Leyburn Market Place or within the remaining catchment area of the River Ure to the West.

GENERAL RULES (for the 2020 online show)

1. The Wensleydale Agricultural Society Ltd is managed by a board of directors elected by the members.
2. The annual show is organised by the show committee consisting of the President, Committee, Treasurer, Secretaries and Members. The President, Vice-President, Committee, Treasurer and Secretaries to be elected annually at the General Meeting.
3. The Committee shall compile the Annual Prize List, and are empowered to make Rules and Bye-Laws necessary for the Annual Show.
4. The Judges shall not award any prize unless exhibits are deemed worthy and no second prize shall be awarded unless there are three entries in a class, except where the Judges specially recommend a prize be awarded. The Section Chief Stewards reserve the right to amalgamate classes.
5. The decision of all judges is FINAL and there is no policy for disputes or challenge procedure - by entering all exhibitors agree to this code.
6. The stewards reserve the right to decide which exhibits are portrayed in the shows online website, entry does not guarantee short listing for inclusion as this will depend on the number of entries.
7. There shall be no entry fee for the Wensleydale Show Online 2020, and no prize money for individual classes, there will however be a prize for the Champion of each section, and at the discretion of the committee and sponsors other prizes awarded as deemed fit.
8. In the livestock classes the herd / flock book number and animal name as well as date of birth and breed must be supplied (if appropriate).
9. The Show Committee reserve the right to change or cancel any aspect of the show without any notification.
10. **All exhibitors agree to their photographs becoming the property of Wensleydale Agricultural Society Ltd unless specifically requested not there will be a request on the entry form, shown by an acceptance of terms tick box.**
11. Photographs presented containing images of young persons under the age of 18 at the date of the photograph, must be accompanied by the consent of the parent/guardian of the young person - by agreement on the entry form.
12. All exhibits must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
13. Local classes are confined to entrants residing within a ten-mile radius of Leyburn Market Place or within the remaining catchment area of the River Ure to the west. However all classes are open unless otherwise stated.
14. All photos submitted should have been taken since the last show in August 2019.
15. No late entries will be accepted and no substitutions allowed.

The Committee shall consist of not less than 15 members who shall have the entire management of the Society, subject to the existing Rules, and five shall form a quorum.

The elected Committee to have power to co-opt additional members.

The Chairman, Treasurer and Secretaries shall be ex-officio members of all Committees.

Annual Subscriptions shall become due and payable on the first day of June in each year.

Subscriptions remaining unpaid on August 1st in each year shall be considered in arrears.

A member who is in arrears with their subscriptions shall not vote at any meeting of the Society, nor enjoy any of its privileges.

The Annual General Meeting shall be held each year in the Leyburn area.

- H4 Vase of any garden flowers** - six stems
- H5 Children's class** (age up to 12 years) **Garden in a seed tray**
- H6 Wonky veg** - most amusing shaped vegetable, does not need to be home grown!

(1 entry per exhibitor per class, still photograph, judged on presentation, sadly tasting impossible!)

- F1 A novelty decorated birthday cake**
- F2 An individual cold sweet in a wine glass**
- F3 A gateaux** that the judge would most like a bite out of!
- F4 A starter using fish**
- F5 Local class:** (see rule 13) **An illustrated family recipe for a fruit pie**

Handicrafts

(1 entry per exhibitor per class, still photograph unless otherwise stated)

- A1 A cushion**, any medium
- A2 A door stop**, any medium
- A3 A piece of homemade jewellery**
- A4 A garment using wool**
- A5 An up-cycled item**, any medium, *video film of the item, showing any moving parts or special features (1 min max)*

Young People's Classes

(under 16 please state age with entry, still photograph)

- C1 A photograph** of a "Tractor at Work"
- C2 Using a computer to write a short story entitled** - "What I did in lockdown"
- C3 Something that I have baked**
- C4 Something that I have up-cycled**
- C5 A painted stone**

Vintage Vehicles

(A still photograph taken since last show day, unless otherwise stated please send a short (<50 words) resume of your vehicle for publishing including its age and specification)

- V1 Best vintage classic car**
- V2 Best modern classic car**
- V3 Best commercial vehicle** (including Land Rovers etc.)
- V4 Best vintage tractor still working.** *Video of a tractor working e.g. pulling a trailer, hay-time, ploughing (2 mins max), not to have been entered in C1*

Horses

(Please keep safety at the forefront of your performance. Riding hats must be worn when mounted)

- EQ1 Ridden heavy horse:** The Alan Hutchinson Memorial Class
Video of individual show of your choice, to include: a square halt sideways on to camera, walk and trot on both reins and a canter with feathers flying! (4 mins max)
- EQ2 Carriage driving**, Concours d'elegance - any horse, any vehicle (*still photograph taken since last show*)
- EQ3 Most adorable local donkey** (see rule 13) (*still photograph*)
- EQ4 In-hand 'Rising Star'** horse / pony, any age not entered in any show before (*still, side-on photograph*)
- EQ5 Best family horse** – *video (5 mins max) showing a well behaved, versatile family horse at home. Freestyle with safety in mind- could include: obstacle course, trick, opening a gate/ a change of rider*
- EQ6 Fancy Dress (a) Adults (b) Children** under 16 (*Still photograph, mounted or with horse in hand*)

Poultry

(1 entry per class, still photograph taken since last show day. NO professional pictures or artificial backgrounds)

- P1 Any variety large fowl**
- P2 Any variety waterfowl**
- P3 Best bantam**
- P4 Plate of three eggs** large or bantam (waterfowl included)
- P5 Children's class: Best decorated egg**
- P6 Best backyard laying hen** (Local class, see rule 13)

Sheep

(Open to all breeds. To be judged on a side view, still photograph unless stated)

- S1 Young handler** (under 16) exhibitor to prepare and lead the animal, *video (4 mins max)*
- S2 Ram** – shearing or over
- S3 Ewe** - shearing or over
- S4 Ram lamb**
- S5 Ewe lamb**
- S6 Local class** - (see rule 13) - not already entered in any class above

Cattle

Natural background, no embellishments or winnings on display. Animals can be photographed in their natural state on farm. Cattle should be correctly tagged. Open to all breeds.

Dairy

(To be judged on two photographs, one side and one rear view unless otherwise stated)

- D1 Young handler** (under 16) exhibitor to prepare and lead the animal, *video (4 mins max)*
- D2 Maiden heifer** born after 1st April 2019
- D3 Heifer in milk**
- D4 Best Junior cow in milk** – 2nd or 3rd lactation
- D5 Best Senior cow in milk** – 4th lactation and above
- D6 Best animal from local area** – (see rule 13) not already entered in any class above

Beef

(To be judged on two photographs, one side and one rear view unless otherwise stated)

- B1 Young handler** (under 16) exhibitor to prepare and lead the animal, *video (4 mins max)*
- B2 Best Native breed cow** in calf or with calf at foot
- B3 Best Continental breed cow** in calf or with calf at foot
- B4 Best Commercial breed animal** - steer or heifer
- B5 Futurity class:** *A video of a group of three calves born in 2020 by the same sire, filmed at grass (3 mins max)*
- B6 Best animal from local area** – (see rule 13) not already entered in any class above
